Our tentative dates for the next trip to Quantico/DC will be leaving Wisconsin early Saturday, September 14, 2019 returning Saturday, September 21, 2019. As of now, we plan to be in DC late Saturday night and returning on Saturday September 21st. We really don't have the agenda made up yet. We will be going to the Marine Expo on Wednesday September 18<sup>th</sup> that is the first day of the expo. **Last time we got to see the Silent Drill Team, Marine Corps Drum and Bugle Corps and we also got to meet and shake hands with the Commandant and Sgt. We will leave very early Saturday morning and driving straight thru. We should get there sometime that night. We will get a good night's sleep in the motel and Sunday we will start our events. ### The costs in 2019:

**Bus: \$300.00 per person. Marines transportation is or can be picked up by the Detachments in the Department.**

**Hotel: \$40.00 per night per person for 7 nights, or \$280.00 per person for all 7 night. If you want a single room by yourself it is or will be \$80.00 per night or \$560.00.**

This is a great opportunity to bring young Marines and more mature Marines together for a great time, learning about the Corps and our traditions.
